The primary aim of this website is to provide a centralized platform that showcases the COPILOT project's objectives, resources, and opportunities. In addition to serving as an informational hub for the COPILOT project, the website also integrates the Pilots4U database, offering users access to a wide array of PDIs across Europe.

## 2 Information provided on the landing page

This website offers information tailored to the needs of various stakeholders in the bioeconomy sector. Key information includes:

- **Overview of the COPILOT Project:** The website provides detailed information about the COPILOT project, including its objectives, partners, and the impact it seeks to achieve in the bioeconomy sector.
- **P4U Database:** The integrated P4U database is a key resource, offering a comprehensive listing of PDIs. Each facility profile includes essential details such as location, capabilities, and contact information.
- **Open Calls:** The website features a dedicated section for Open Calls (**OPEN CALL 1: Call4BioPlants** and **OPEN CALL 2: Call4BioInnovators**), where users can find information on current and upcoming opportunities within the COPILOT project.
- **News and Events:** The news and events section keeps users informed about the updates specific to the COPILOT project.
- **Contact and Support:** Users can access contact details for further inquiries and receive support for navigating the site or accessing the information they need.

## 3 Launch Details

- **Launch Date:** The landing page was launched on 16/07/2024.
- **Pre-Launch Review:** The page content was reviewed and approved by all project partners.
- **Promotion:** the launch was announced in conjunction with the opening of Open Calls 1 & 2 and shared on the LinkedIn pages of BBEUPP, COPILOT, and project partners, ensuring broad visibility among stakeholders.
- **Post-launching activities:** On 12/08/2024, the Open Call annex documents were uploaded to the website. Subsequently, on 26/08/2024, details for the first eight COPILOT events were added.

## 4 The Step-wise approach to a Pilots4U powered by COPILOT website

From the project's inception, the COPILOT website has been closely linked with the existing P4U platform, which currently hosts the "old" database at [www.biopilots4u.eu](http://www.biopilots4u.eu). During months 2 and 3 of the project, a preliminary website is designed, built, and hosted at [www.copilot-project.eu](https://www.copilot-project.eu) to serve as an interim solution.

To create a future-proof platform, the project will engage a software development company, "US" (<https://about-us.be/>), to build the new "Pilots4U powered by COPILOT" database and platform. This

new platform's software will be fully integrated with the website to ensure optimal performance and will include features that support the business model, enabling the platform to be self-sustaining beyond the project's completion.

Since the specific software requirements and necessary features were not fully defined at the project's start, the preliminary website will temporarily serve the project's needs until the final platform is developed. Once the software specifications and business model features are finalized and the new database/platform is in development, the final website will be constructed. This final website, hosting the new database/platform, will be available at [www.biopilots4U.eu](http://www.biopilots4U.eu). Visitors accessing [www.copilot-project.eu](http://www.copilot-project.eu) will be automatically redirected to [www.biopilots4U.eu](http://www.biopilots4U.eu), ensuring a seamless user experience across both URLs.
